



Director of Hockey

Reporting to the management executive via the coaching committee this role entails but is not limited to the following:

- Waterford Hockey Club Men's and Women's 1^{sts}, division one team coach for the upcoming 2020/21 season.
- The development and implementation of a team strength and conditioning plan, coaching programme and strategy for the season.
- The team selection, communications, planning, organisation and execution of all weekly training sessions and matches.
- Instil a 'top down' playing style and club ethos through-out all levels.
- Be available to liaise with and advise all club coaches.
- Attend two training sessions per season with each coach, to assist and guide them.
- Wear club sponsorship clothing and partake in club promotional activities when requested.
- The position is subject to Garda vetting.
- When clashes arise, prioritise their coaching position ahead of their playing career.

Candidates should demonstrate the following:

- Positive attitude and ability to maintain a positive team environment.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to plan and implement high quality and varied coaching sessions that have both individual and team focus.
- Willingness to liaise with fellow coaches to maintain high levels of player development and ongoing possibilities for player progression.
- The successful candidate will be expected to act in accordance with WHC and Hockey Ireland's code of ethics.

Five years coaching experience and minimum level 2 qualification are essential.

The position will commence August 10th 2020 at the latest and conclude when all team league and cup matches for the 2020/21 season are completed.
